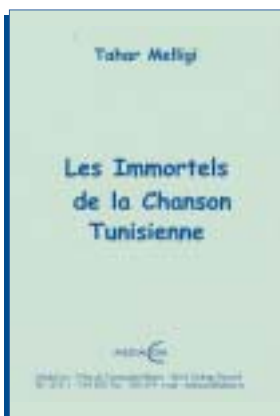

Political developments of recent years have led to a considerable increase in Europe and the USA, of interest in the Arab world and in Islam. No comprehensive international reference work has taken this development into account so far. However, the need for such a compendium, with contemporary persons of this region, is great. The **Arab-Islamic Biographical Archive. Series II (AIBA II)** fills this gap. It follows on directly from the first part, the *Arab-Islamic Biographical Archive*, providing biographies of personalities from the Arab and Islamic world of the 20th and 21st centuries.

In **AIBA II** about 70,000 people are represented; significant, prominent people as well as persons who were probably less well-known until now; persons from almost all groups in society, and of all political and ideological inclinations.

Geographically, the archive extends from the Mediterranean region right across the Arabian Peninsula, Iran and Central Asia, to Islamic India and South-East Asia.

The **AIBA II** includes about 150 general biographical encyclopaedias, regionally orientated collective biographies, biographical encyclopaedias covering specific groups of people and professions (e.g. artists, musicians, journalists, scientists, politicians, foreign travellers, specialists in Middle Eastern and oriental studies), biographical articles from general encyclopaedias of the modern Orient, as well as essays from professional journals containing biographies. Many of the evaluated source works were published only in small editions and are barely accessible.



Most of the approximately 90,000 biographical entries are written in English and French, with some also in Italian and German, and others written bilingually (e.g. Arabic-French, Arabic-German or English-French). They were compiled from sources published between 1885 and 2004. The works in Arabic have been provided with English abstracts, thus making them accessible to a greater number of users.

The compilation of the biographies in the **Arab-Islamic Biographical Archive. Series II** is unique, not only in regard to the cultural group and the underlying geographical region, but also the variety of the source works upon which it draws. It is an important enrichment for every library.
